## Who will you vote for?

If you didn't know, the general election is coming up and you get to vote on the 7<sup>th</sup> May.

But you can only vote if you have registered, which you should have already done. If you're reading this, it's too late. If you have registered to vote here, you are able to vote on a local and parliamentary level.

On a local level, David Collett is in the ward of Loughborough Nanpantan. Local elections come round every 4 years. Four political parties have put candidates forward, the Conservatives (Geoffrey Parsons, Joan Smidowicz), the Greens (Elisha Shamba, Jessica Tickell), Labour (Mike Cahill, Ruth Sinclair) and the Liberal Democrats (Steve Coltman, Shelia Shaw).

For the parliamentary elections, you are voting for your Member of Parliament for the Loughborough seat. There are five candidates from the Conservatives (Nicky Morgan), the Greens (Matt Sisson), Labour (Matthew O'Callaghan), Liberal Democrats (Steve Coltman) and the UK Independence Party (Bill Piper).

Tonight at the union is the general elections bubble debate. It starts at 6.30pm and is planned to last 2 hours. If you still want to watch it, and can't get down, LSU Media are live streaming it online.
